- Ensure control of project schedules, invoicing, and cash flow.
- Organize and supervise site activities - site monitoring with the site coordinator and facilitate contacts between internal engineering and suppliers.
- Negotiate and resolve ongoing problems with the client by promoting a relational and contractual approach.
- Capture, analyze and share lessons learned throughout the project.
- Organize technical review meetings of projects and coordinate projects documentation.
- Supervise and participate in procurement (prepare bids, analyze, negotiate with subcontractors)
- Transport monitoring and coordination.
- Keep schedules updated and coordinate critical path priorities.
- Review of quality issues and risks at site with the client and internal resources.
- Maintenance of HSE training for projects, on-site activities etc.
